Please meet at Guerrero's on the corner of Highway 1 and Reina Del Mar to walk in solidarity with CSEA.

If you wish to speak at the Board Meeting on Wednesday:

You will have three minutes for your comment. If your comment is about counselors, teachers, or CSEA cuts, you may need to wait until the agenda item comes up. The public comment at the start of the meeting is for items not on the agenda. Your decision if you wait or still speak at this part of the meeting. Just know, the Board may cut you off.

Virtual Speakers - when the Zoom meeting begins enter in the chat "General Public Comment" if it is general comment. If it is an agenda item comment, please put the agenda item number and letter in the chat.

In Person Speakers - When you enter the District Office there will be a sign-in table with a stack of yellow slips of paper. Fill this out and find Barbara Bualat. She is seated in front of the smart board with Stan. If the room is too crowded or you come a bit late, you can hand the slip of paper to Josie who is usually seated by the door and she'll pass it to Barbara.

When you arrive at the Boardroom, please keep chairs available for the Ocean Shore students and parents who will be opening the meeting with flag salute, land acknowledgement, etc. Please allow the parents the seats to see their children in action. They will likely leave shortly after.

Overflow Room - Thank you Vallemar for securing the band room as a place for people to gather and watch the meeting. The Board Room is small. It will be cold. The Vallemar band room will be open with the meeting projected for people to view. We are welcome to wait here and follow along with the meeting and return to the Board Room when the agenda item you want to address is about to come up.

Communications:

After the procedural opening of the meeting the communications will begin. Probably around 6:30ish. LSEA will speak. CSEA will speak. Then the public can speak about general topics. The School Board and Superintendent will then share their correspondence and communication.
